We have arrived

Wow, it is amazing how fast six months can go by. It seems like just yesterday that Jennifer and I started talking about the Lord sending us out from our home into the mission field. And now here we are, we have made the move from Olathe Kansas 2000 plus miles to Eatonville Washington. You can read about our move on our blog, but I wanted to send out a note to all of you with some information I do not want to publish on the blog.

It has been incredible to watch how God has set up our move from the very beginning. God knew exactly where He was taking us and has had many things already established for us. He provided the incredible house we are now living in, with the great view (pictured below). I told the Lord when He told us we were going that if I was going to leave my home I would really like to go to a place in the mountains and have a great view, and He provided just that.

When we came out to visit Trinity Aviation back in November we knew God had something very special for this place, something very important for us to be involved in. Shortly after our visit I got a phone call from the director. He wanted me to know of a few things that had happened with the school; how they were having some issues with their program and were not sure exactly what their forward plans were going to look like but they were going to move forward. He wanted me to know these things so that we could make a good decision about whether or not to come out to work with Trinity. After talking with him a bit about some of the things that were going on I had the opportunity to inform him that God had given us clear direction that Trinity was the place He was calling us to.

Jennifer and I knew God had a purpose for us even beyond working with Trinity in Washington. We had a vision of working in the community here in Eatonville, a largely un-churched community where it is estimated that 80% of the 2100 people have never even stepped foot in a church. It really is a mission field all on its own. We are still praying about where God will set us for a church home. We visited a good church this Sunday with a lot of outreach opportunity that the leadership is praying for some good leadership assistance. It is a church focused on reaching the town of Eatonville and there is a lot of potential for us to serve in ministry, including youth ministry again.

I am thankful that God confirmed to us so strongly that Eatonville is where we were being set. Please continue to pray as I work with the group at Trinity Aviation. There are several areas that have some issues, especially in leadership, that God wants to deal with in order for this school to become established where He wants it to be. I am very excited about the opportunities to work with this group and they have asked me to fully take over the flight department. Students will return for training starting the first of February. Before that time I will be working on finishing up the syllabus I have been working on for the last couple of years. I have a lot of work to get done!!

Jennifer has been hard at work getting the house all set up. We have been here just over a week and do not have any boxes or bins in the house, pictures are hung, the kids are in school and things continue to progress towards becoming permanent Washington residents. Right now things have slowed down a bit and we are getting rested up during this time in preparation for what God has planned for us. We are expecting to get very busy working with a church, the schools and who knows what else.

We are very blessed to be working where we are. We know God has great plans for us here, He sent us. It is pretty exciting to think about how He is going to take care of everything as neither Jennifer or I have a paying job and the Lord never directed us to do the “missionary thing” of raising support. But He is faithful and will provide all that is needed.
